

Central Texas Quarter Horse Association
Membership Rules and Regulations
As Of 2008

1. Annual membership fees are as follows:

Full Working Membership	\$ 25.00
(Includes all unmarried children living at home until age 18)	
Associate Non-Working Membership	\$100.00
(Same privileges as working membership, except no voting rights on any issue)	
Youth Membership (age 18 to 24)	\$ 15.00
Senior Membership (age 60 & over)	\$ 15.00

 - Members joining after June 30th will have no voting rights in the election of officers for that year.

2. Membership fees must be renewed in January each year.

3. Prospective members are encouraged to attend any regular meeting or event of the CTQHA. If you are interested in joining CTQHA, written application on CTQHA's Membership Application must be submitted for approval of CTQHA. This vote will be taken at the next regular meeting of CTQHA. Prospective member may not be in attendance at this meeting to consider application.

4. There are to be no alcoholic beverages inside the chain link fence at any time by members or guests at any scheduled CTQHA event or meeting.

5. Regular meetings are held every 3rd Monday of each month (excluding December) at 7:00 p.m. in the CTQHA arena/club house (Small Vernon Room).

6. Members are responsible for supporting the club sponsored activities, workdays, events, and meetings. Minimum requirements are:
 - Work at least one four hour shift at the registered show (Spring)
 - Work one four hour shift in at least three of the five Fall Open Horse Shows
 - Attend five of the eleven regular scheduled meetings in that yearBenefits of this membership include, but are not limited to:
 - Free ride night every Tuesday evening from 6:30 till 9:30 p.m.
 - Free meal at Meet & Eat night, 3rd Monday meeting night, February through September
 - Steak dinner for the club following the Spring Registered Show-usually at May meeting
 - Stall rentals and RV hookups at Registered Show and Fall Open Shows are discounted to members
 - Shavings can be purchased at cost
 - Free year end Banquet Meal for members who have worked at shows.
 - Ability to ride in outdoor arena (no lights) any time it is not rented.

Failure to meet the minimum membership requirements will result in a loss of voting rights in the election of officers and require probation for the following year. If a member fails to meet the minimum requirements for two years in a row, that member will only be eligible for a non-working membership the following year. There may be exemptions granted, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, to any of the requirements on request.

7. Tuesday ride nights are open to all members every Tuesday except the last two weeks in December, and Youth Expo week. Some ride nights may be made available to the public, to encourage membership, as voted on by the club members.
8. The main purpose for the Tuesday night rides is to make available to the members a general ride opportunity. There will be a general ride from 6:30 p.m. till 8:00 p.m. At that time, there will be a vote by those present to determine what special event (barrels, poles, trail, etc) will be run till closing time.
9. These rules may be amended by a majority of the voting member at a regular meeting or a special meeting called by the President. Any changes to these rules must be posted in the arena/concession/meeting room to be valid.
